- Dialogue between and instruction of the parents on many educational topics,
- Suggestions for parents in how to support their children during the educational process,
- Joy, time and space to meet up, exchange experiences and ask questions,
- Parent guides who provide the best support on site.

How does it work?

- The group of parents meets regularly at the school
- Exchange of experiences with other parents
- Improved contact with teachers
- Materials and ideas for joint activities with the child

- Counselling and support in school matters
- Multilingual material for spending time with your child
- Developing your own language skills and those of your child

What is the role of the school?
